### Growing Need

30 million functionally-impaired elderly patients take 8 to 10 medications and have 6 to 12 chronic medical conditions. Roughly 86% of NPs see patients covered by Medicare and Medicaid. An estimated 11,000 new NPs completed their academic programs in 2010-2011 to enter growing elderly care market

Most EMR applications are designed for patient encounter at clinics, not for home-bound elderly patients. They are also not designed to work well with IT compatible mobile diagnostic equipment such as portable ultrasound, x-ray, dialysis, and sleep lab diagnostic and smart phones
